

1. BENAYAT SYSTEM

1.1 Benayat System

Benayat building permit portal is the kingdom of Bahrain's official system used to issue building permits for all types of building projects.

The system enables the licensed engineering offices to apply for building permits, track their application status, consult with relevant government entities regarding building permits, in process, pay related fees, and apply for other building related services.



2. ENGINEERING OFFICES GUIDELINE

2.1 System Access & Roles

Types of Engineering Offices

1



Publisher Engineering Office

The licensed engineering office assigned by the owner or his representative to design and publish the engineering drawings and submit the application on Benayat portal.

2



Reviewer Engineering Office

The licensed engineering office assigned by the publisher to review drawings, ensure compliance with the building codes, and issue the permit.

3



Supervisor Engineering Office

The licensed engineering office assigned by the publisher to apply for advertisement, road occupation, addresses, service connectivity, construction follow-up, NOC and insurance refund.

To obtain system access & roles in Benayat, the following documents must be provided:

Engineering Office

- Office CRPEP License
- Commercial Registration
- Official Request Letter
- Valid Copy of Owner's Identity Card
- Thermal Certificate

Users Roles

- Fill the Request Form
- Engineer CRPEP License
 Copy of Identity Card



Types of Users Roles and Access on Benayat System:

User

View requests.

4



Manager

- View the requests in (Watch List).
- Forward the requests to senior engineer.
- Internal and external response.

2



Creator

 Create requests as planned, without publishing them.

5



Senior Engineer

- Building permit responsible officer.
- Receive the request in (To Do List).
- External and internal response.

3



Publisher

 Publish his requests and other planned requests created by his entity.

6



Site Engineer

- Access Benayat APP.
- Upload construction followup stages.


2.2 Applying for new building permit.






Obtain pre-approval (special cases)

There are special cases in which applicants must first obtain a preapproval before starting the process of applying for a building permit.

Review the application by the reviewer ____ engineering office.

The publisher engineering office must submit all required drawings and documents to reviewer engineering office of equal or higher category) to review.

The reviewer engineering office must ensure that all drawings match the regulation and requirements to give the approvement on Benayat system.



10 Days

Fees Payment

Fees are paid online on Benayat system.

Apply for building permit.

the publisher engineering office applies for the permit by submitting all the drawings and document required on the Benayat portal.





——— Governmental Entities

Relevant governmental entities check the ability of connecting the project with the network as following:

- -Sanitary Engineering
- -Water Distribution Directorate (WDD).
- -Electricity Distribution Directorate (EDD).



Issuing Building Permit

Once the building permit fees are paid, the system will automatically issue the building permit which remains valid for one year.

2.3 Applying for Addresses & Services

The publisher engineering office assigns a supervisor engineering office who will applies for building services on Benayat system as following: Advertisement, Road Occupation, Addresses and Service Connectivity.

The stage could be completed without applying for service connectivity, but it should be applied later during the building stage.

Services:



Apply for an address and obtain number plate matching the project nature.



Apply to obtain a license to advertise the project details, including the building permit number, supervising engineering office, and contractor's name.



Apply for a permit to allow the occupation of the public or secondary road, or a portion thereof, for the placement of construction materials and scaffolding according to the nature and size of the property and surrounding roads.



Submitting a request to connect the project to electricity, water, and sewage services according to the availability of services in the area.

Note: The application for the services can be submitted either before the construction stages or later, prior to the issuance of the completion certificate.












2.4 Applying for Construction Follow-up

The supervision engineering office must upload the construction stage on Benayat app and then it will be passed to the concerned entities for approval to open the next stage until the final inspection and issuing the NOC .

Note: To apply for construction follow-up, the engineer must be a civil or construction engineer and he should have the site engineer role and licensed from the CRPEP.






3. OWNERS GUIDLINE MANUAL

3.1 Recommendations Before Starting a Project

1



Considerations Before Purchasing the Property

- Ensure the property located in the right zone, which matches the requirements for the project. (Bahrain Interactive Map)
- Ensuring that there are no cuts on the property.
- Ensuring the legal status of the property.
- Availability of services (water, electrical, ...etc.).
- Registering the property in SLRB.

Considerations Before Starting a Project

- Define the project type.
- Choose a certified engineering office.
- Application procedure.
- Choose a certified contractor.

Considerations Before Assigning Engineering Office

- The office should be certified by CRPEP.
- View previous projects.
- Review the contract and ensure their integrity.




Considerations Before Assigning Contractor.

- Ensure that the contractor has an active CR.
- Contracts should be notarized and official.
- Ensure the quality of the building materials.
- Providing the contractor with a valid building permit with stamped drawings.
- Ensure coordination between the supervision office and the contractor.

3.3 Track application & payments

The owner can track the application status by accessing Benayat system and then selecting the following: MY APPLICATIONS \rightarrow TRACK APPLICATION \rightarrow FOR PROPERTY OWNER. Then, the user should enter the application number and the owner's identity number and then the system will show the application status and allow the user to proceed with payment.



3.4 Applying for Insurance Refund on Benayat

Once the supervisor engineering office completes all requirements through Benayat, the concerned municipality will review and approve. If approved, the owner will receive an SMS and email to update the IBAN number for the refund. Once submitted, the owner will receive an SMS confirming transfer of the insurance refund amount.
